#### **Activity Center Anniversary**

January 19 marks the 12<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of the Activity Center. Staff are proud to have online reviews liking the "newness" of the facility. This week some new tabletops were replaced in the loft and lobby. Other than that, it was an average January week with 3 high school games, 10 youth game, and 38 practices at Activity Center, and 10 separate events in the Activity Room. In 2018, there were 351 events in the Activity Room and 2,450 events scheduled in the ice arena.

#### **Glass Lifter**

For the first time, the glass lifter was used at the Activity Center. Purchased with a 50% grant from MNOSHA the glass lifter made much easier and safer work in replacing the 300 lb. piece of glass. The glass broke towards the end of practice. Staff was able to clean up the broken glass and replace the piece with time to spare before the game that followed the practice.

## Warming up at the Ice Arena

With school out this week for teacher in-service and the weather, parents were looking for activities to keep their children busy and active. Fortunately, many of them chose to play pick up hockey this week we took in \$1,022 in pond hockey admissions!
